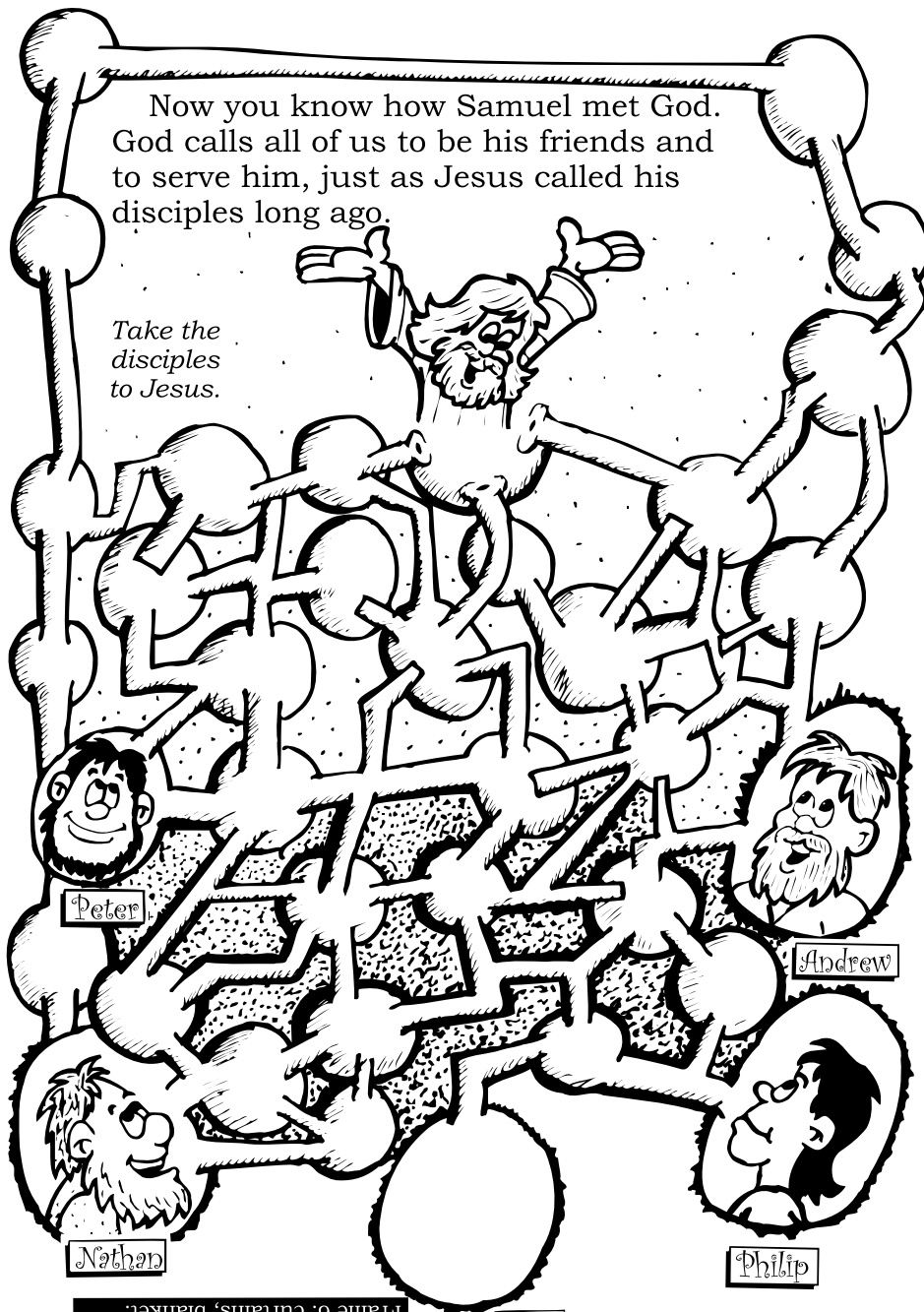


Kidsword

God gave Hannah a son. She named him Samuel. As she had promised, she took him to live with Eli the priest.

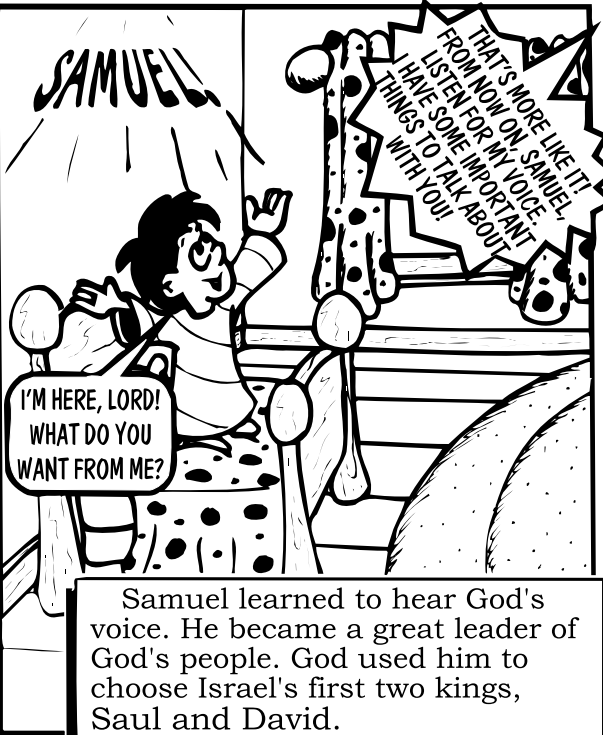
Draw Hannah giving her son to Eli.
