

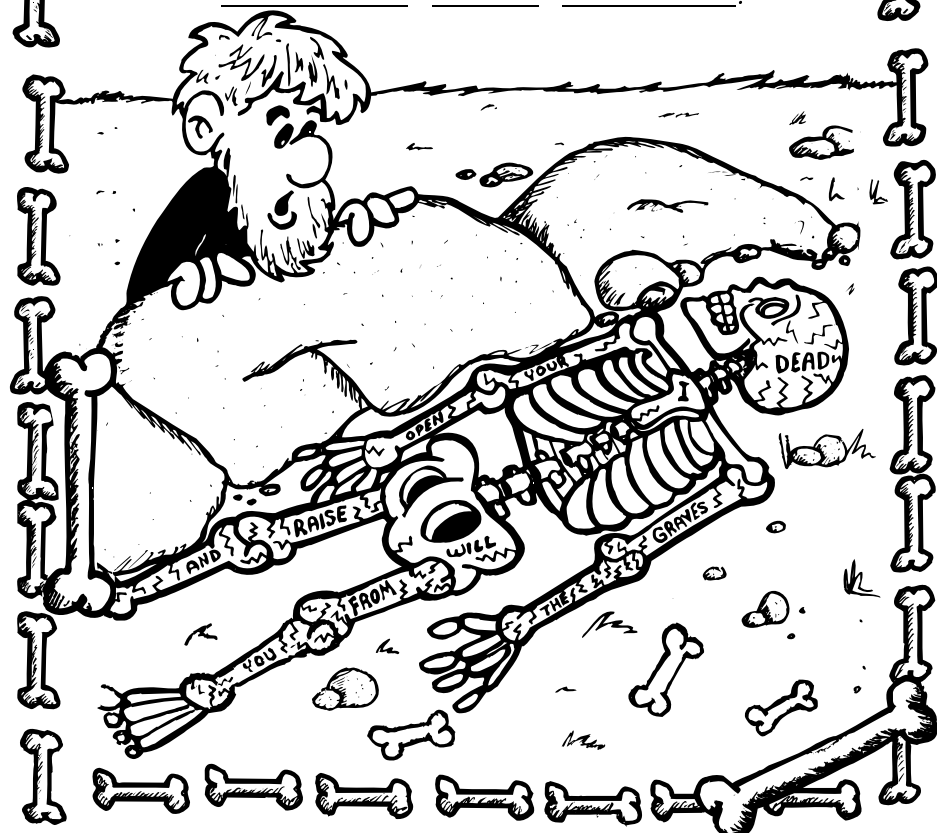


Ezekiel 37

Color the spaces with dots to find the hidden words.

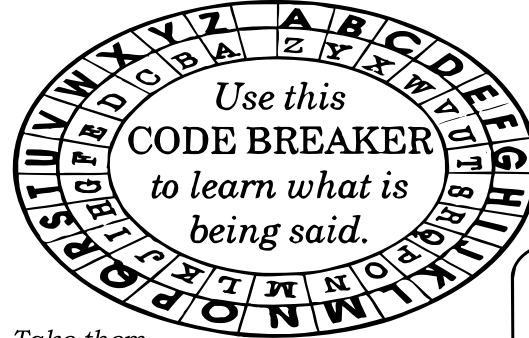

Jesus and his disciples heard that their friend Lazarus was sick.

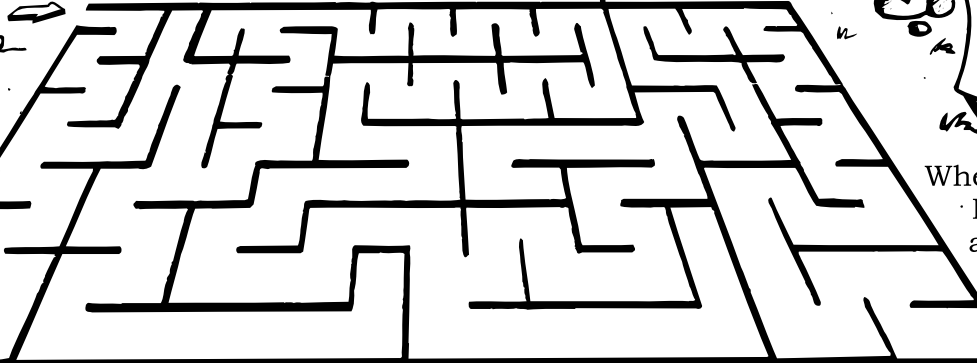

When they arrived, Lazarus had already died.



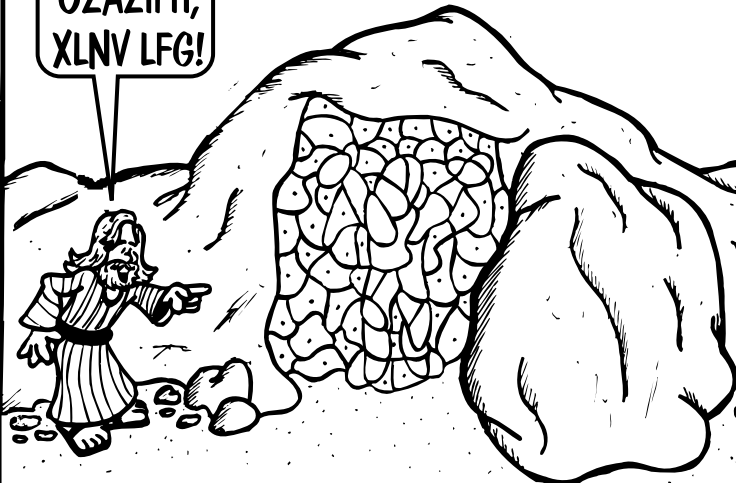

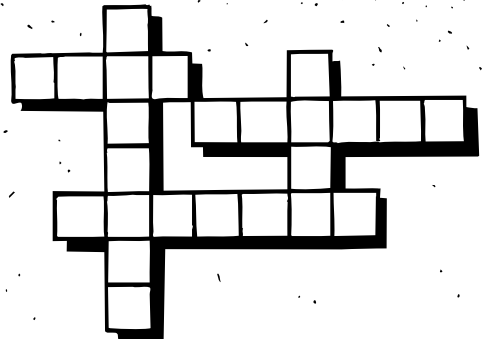
