It's time we helped them _____!"

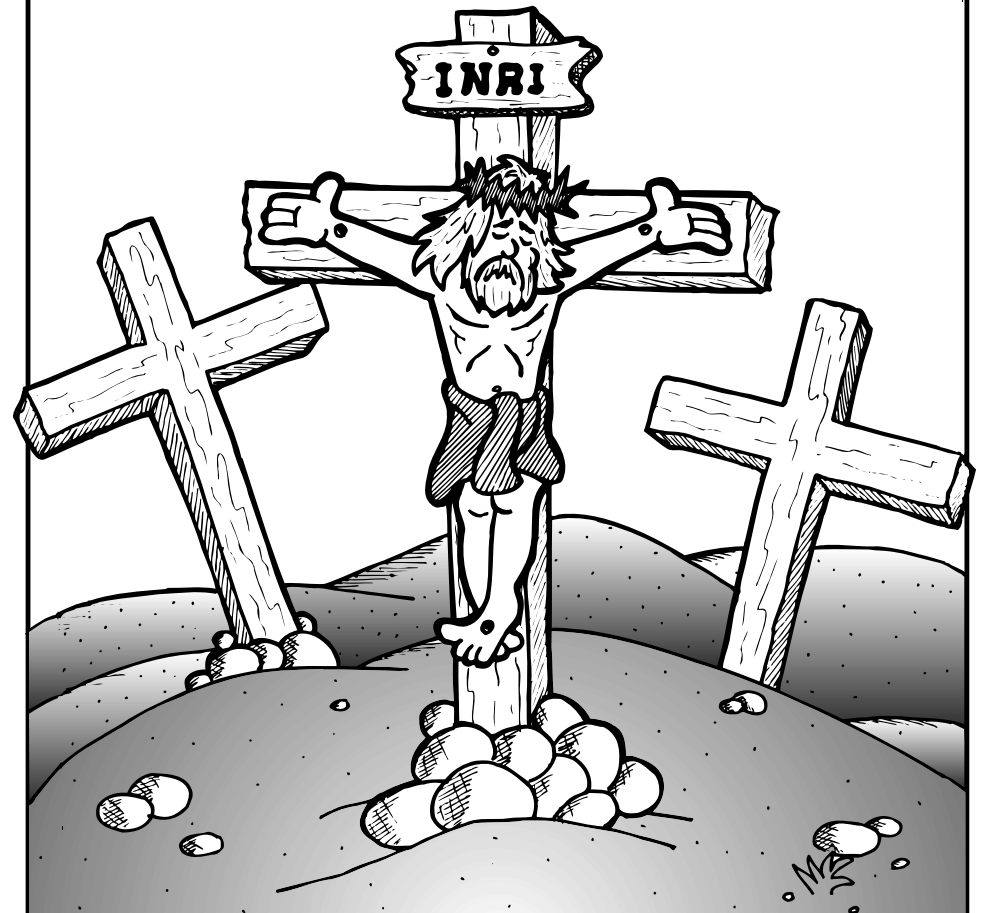
Can you find
