 I think you already *(go, slow, know)*.

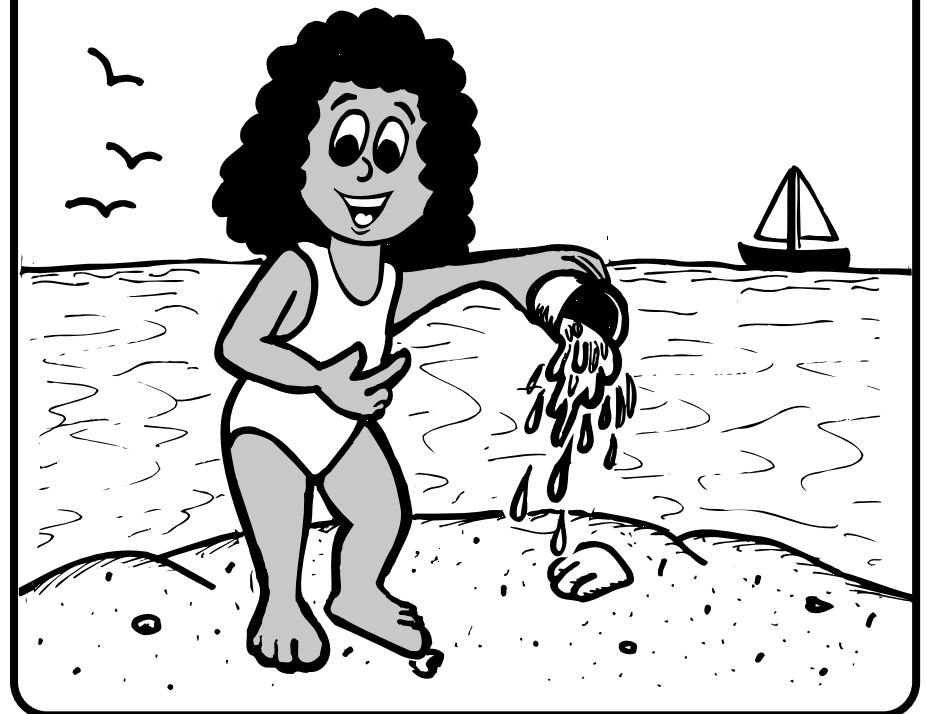
# Little Kidsword

John 4:5-42



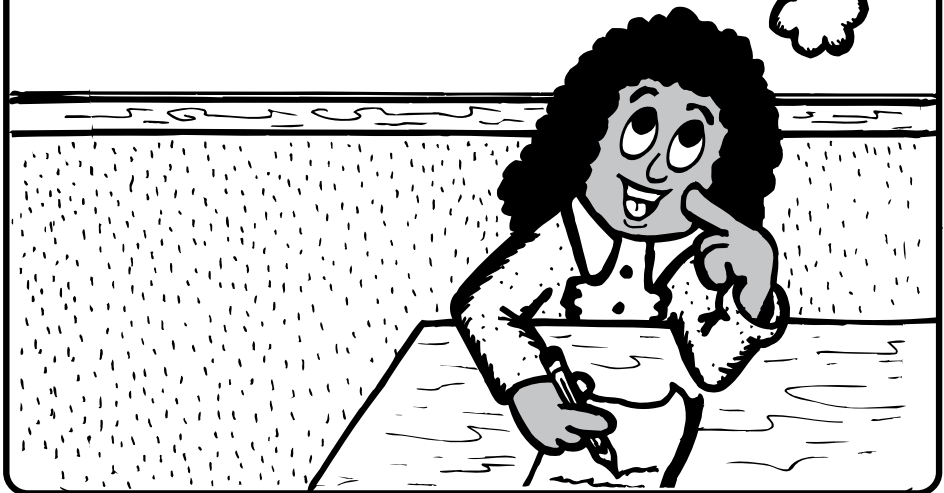
Do you know what I love?
