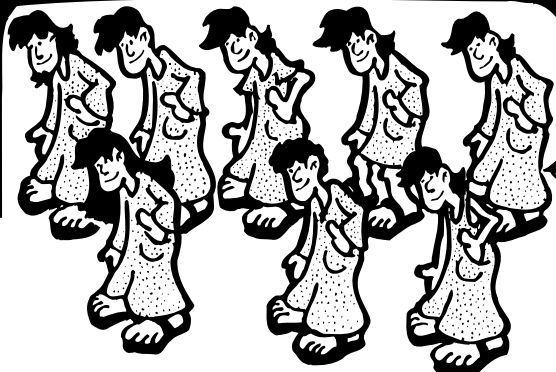
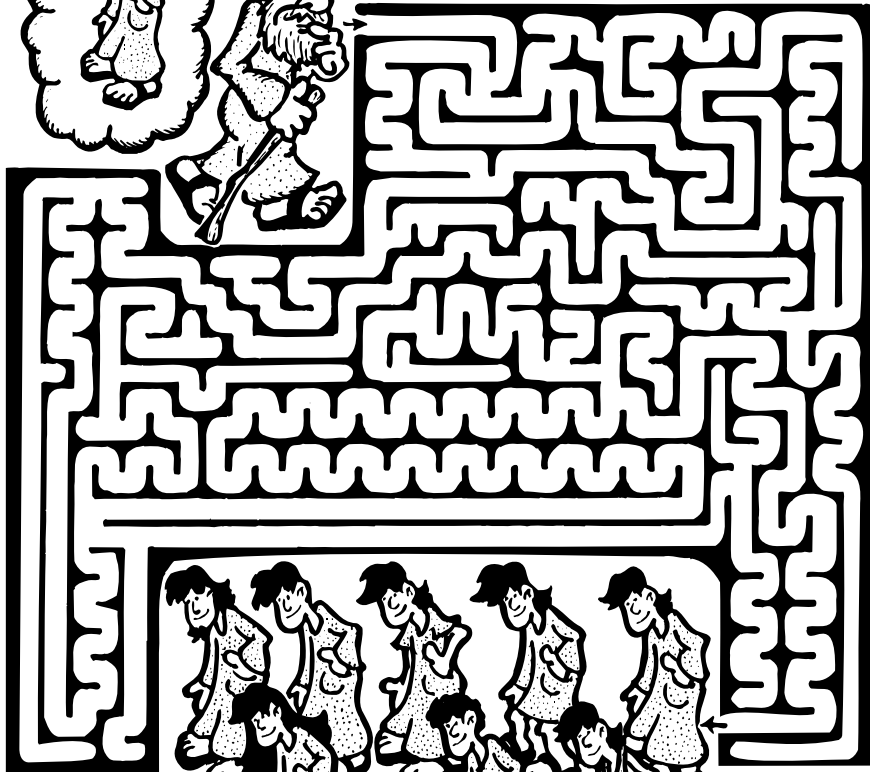
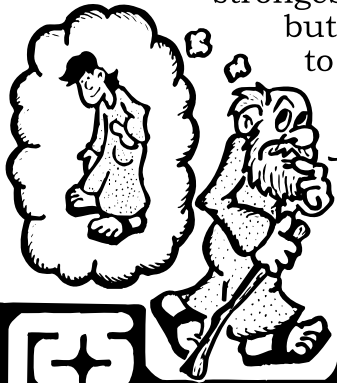
Saul, the king of God's people long ago, disobeyed the Lord and did wicked things. God decided that his people must have a new king.

Samuel found a man named Jesse who had eight sons. God told Samuel which one of them He wanted as the new King.

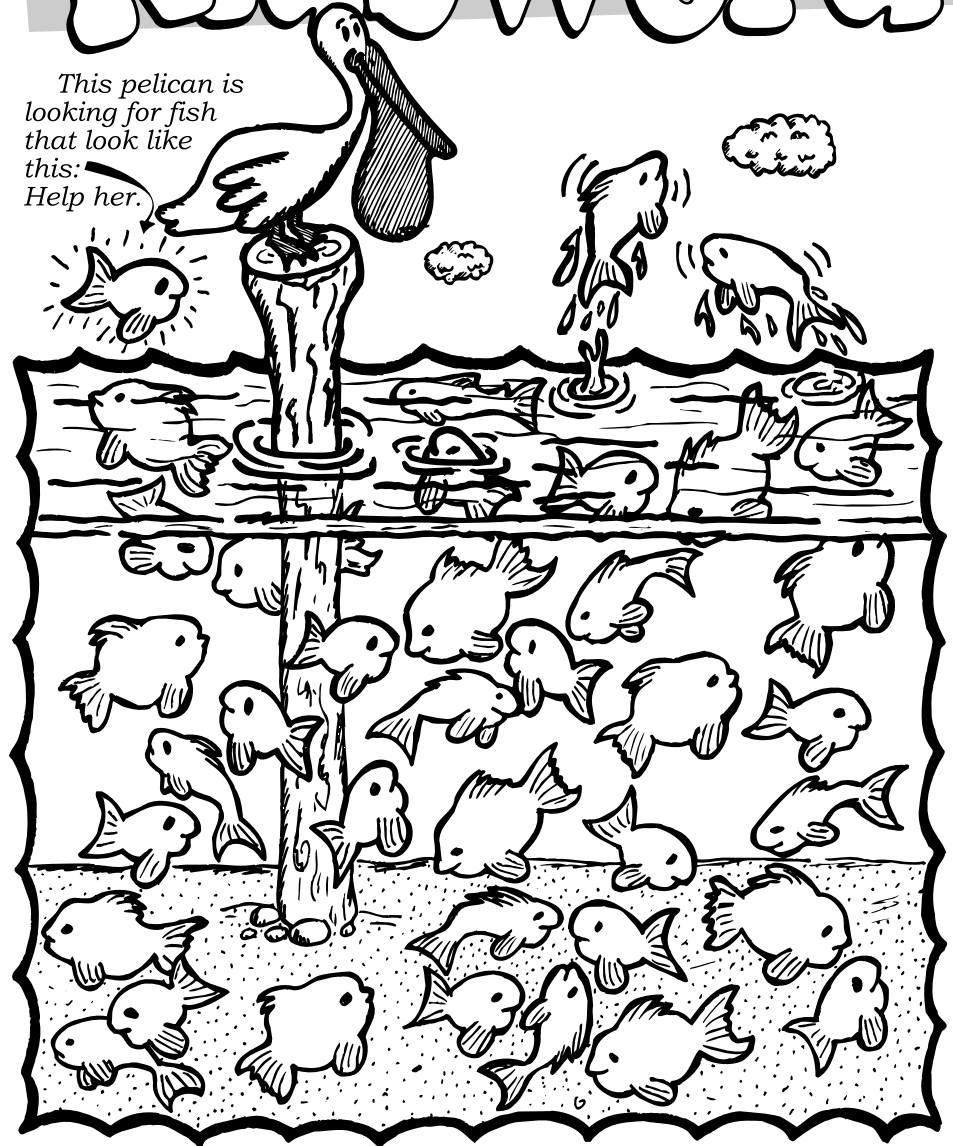
His name was David. He wasn't the oldest, strongest, or best looking of Jesse's sons, but he was the one that God wanted to be the king.

What do you think his parents said when they discovered he was blind?

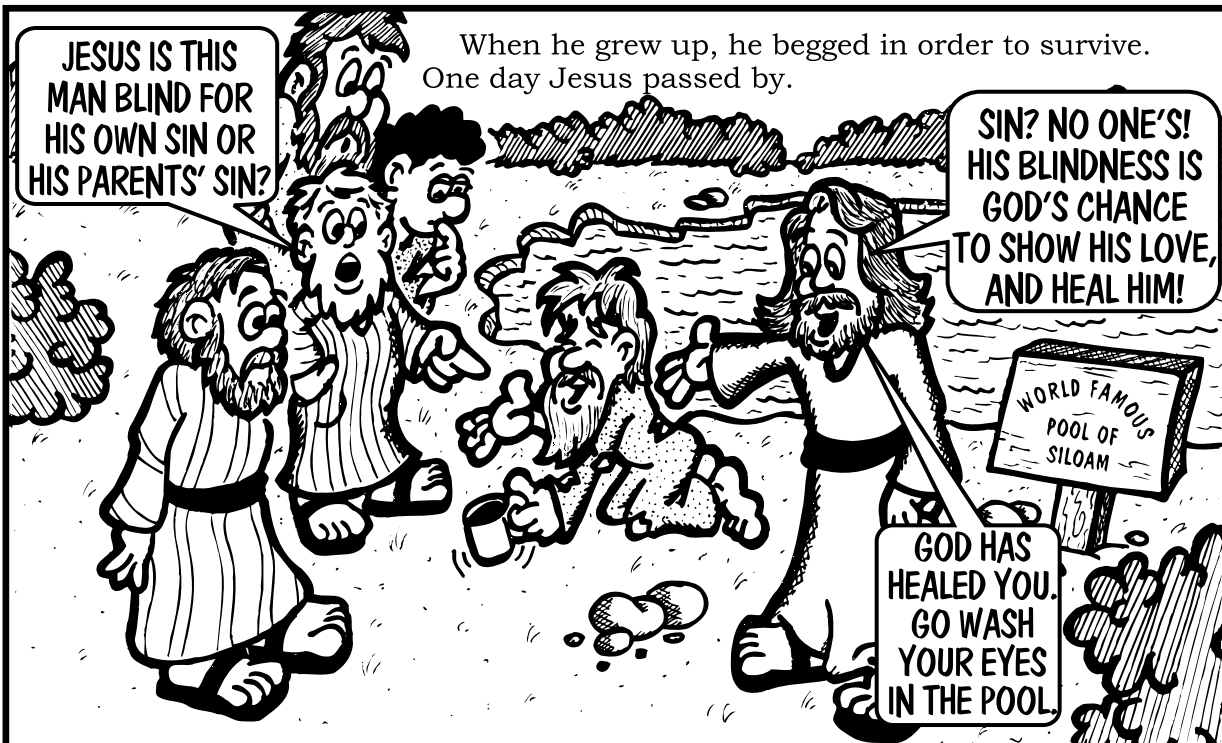

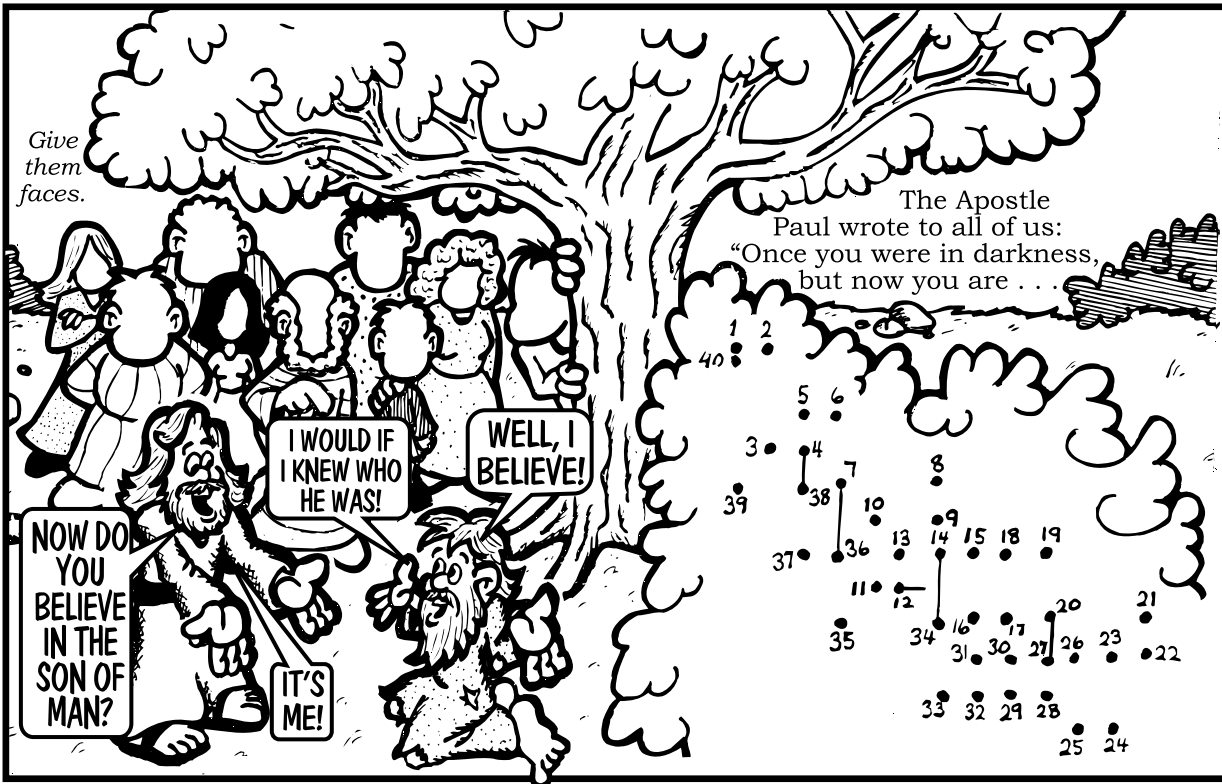
