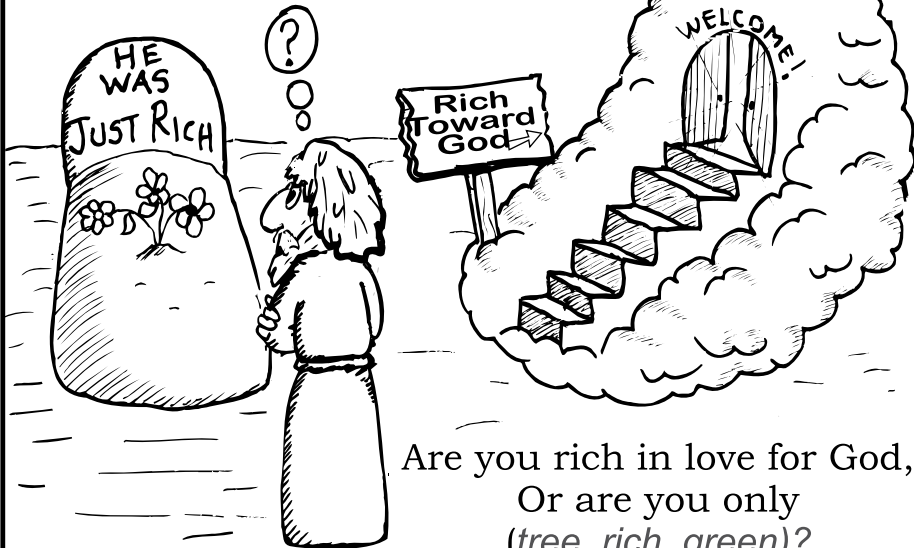


Then suddenly he heard a voice,

# Little Kidsword

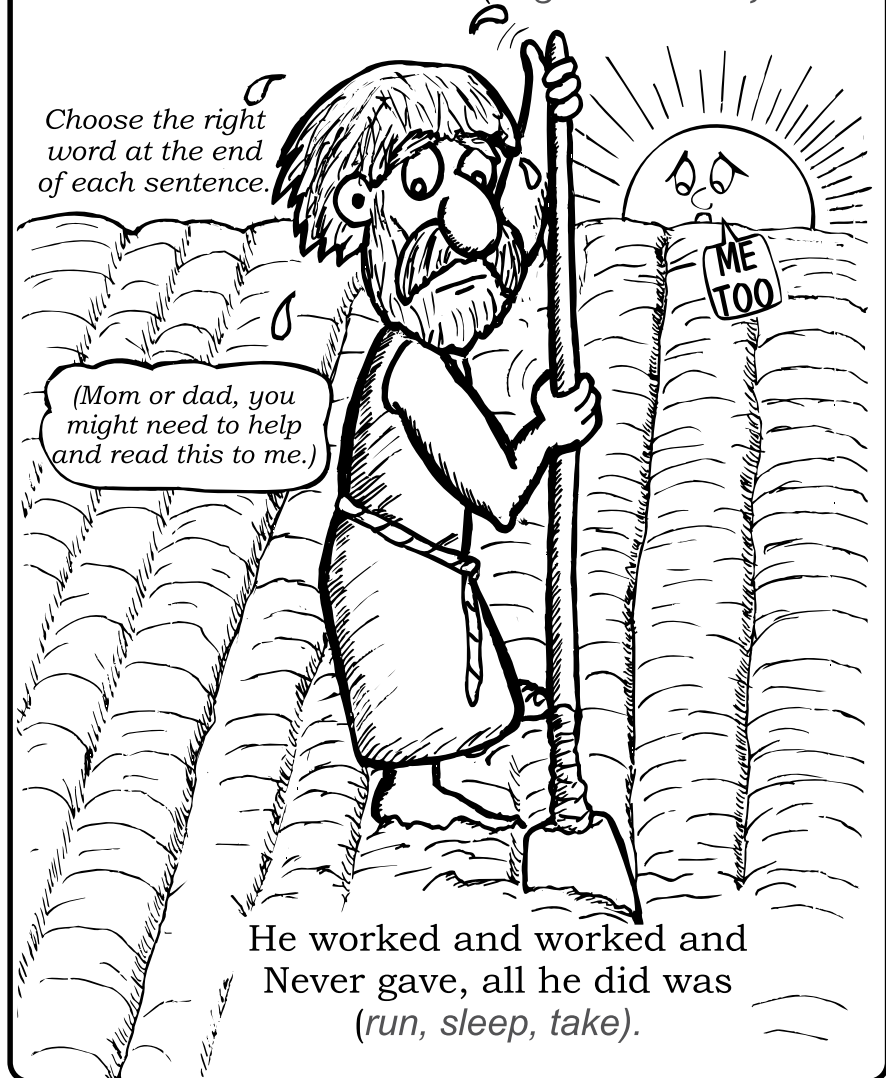
Luke 12:13-21

(*run, sleep, take*).



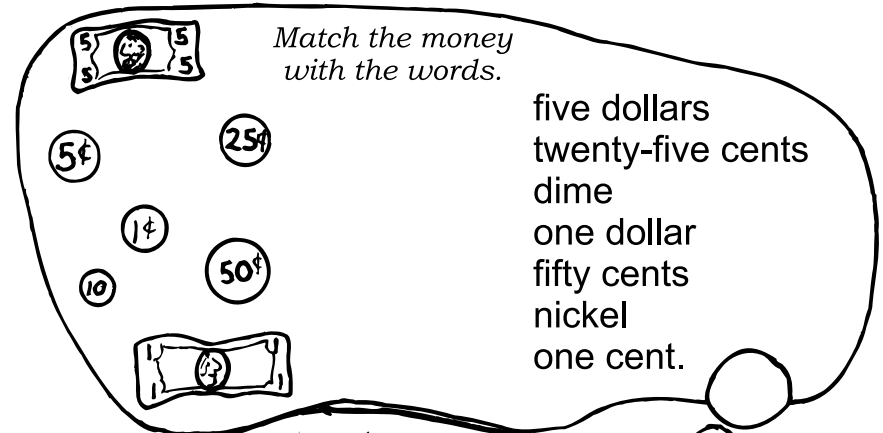
He worked all year to keep

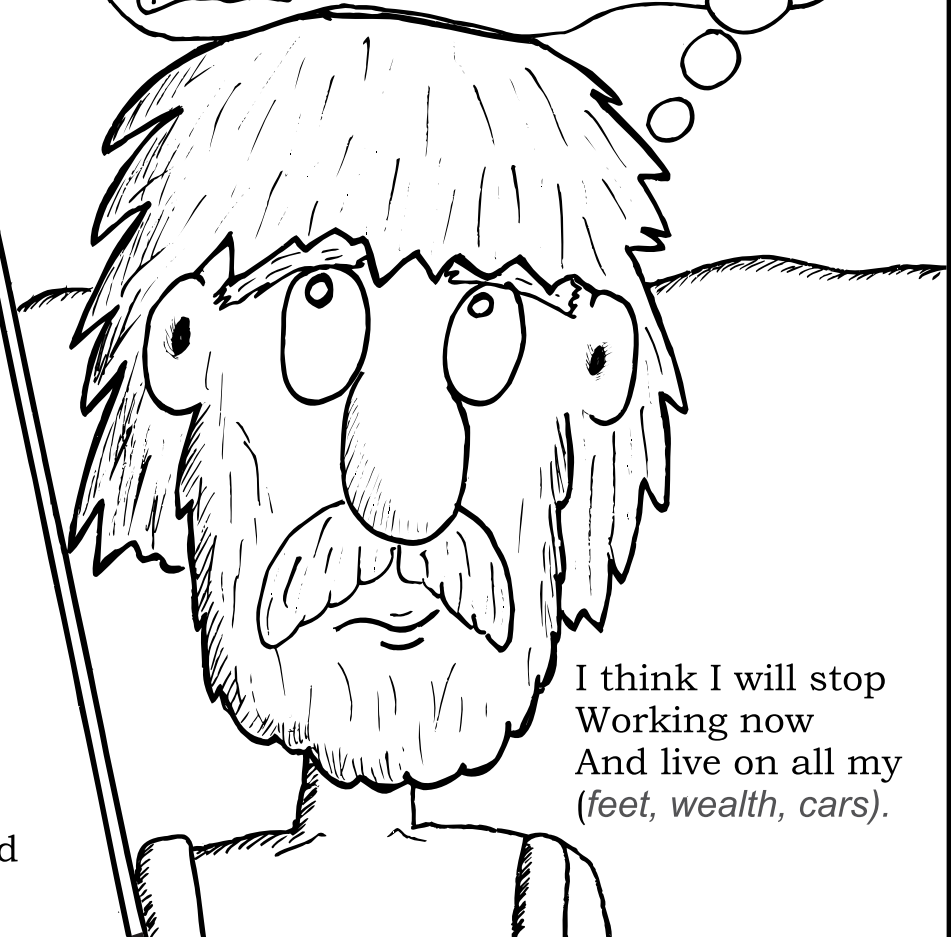
He worked for years until his barns were full and
