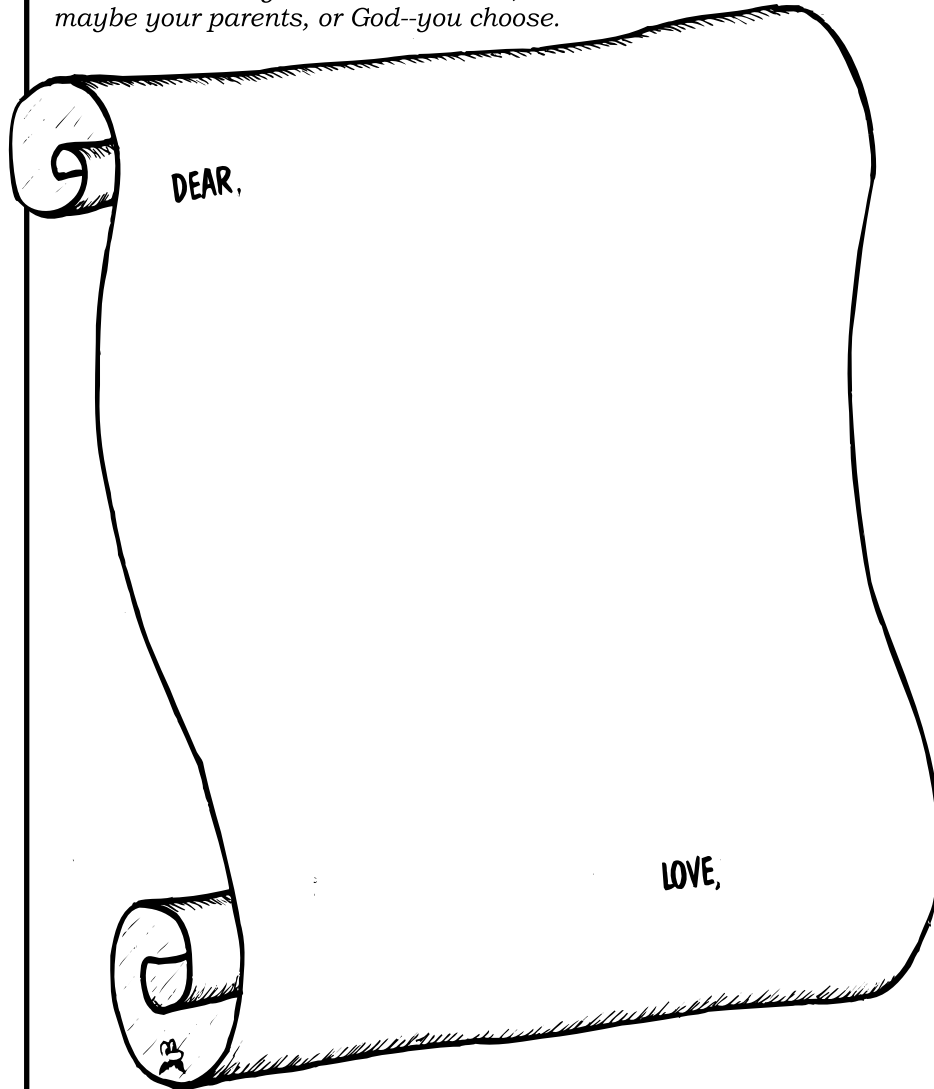

## THANK YOU?

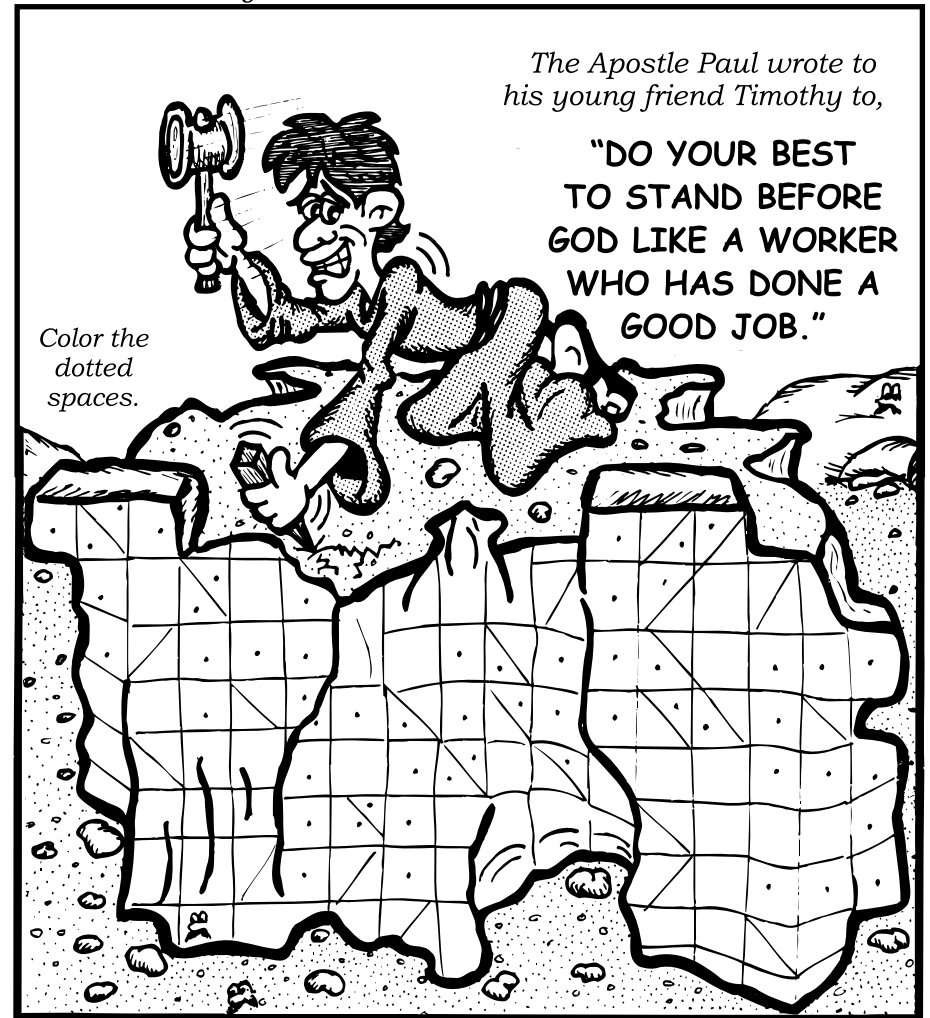
Write a thank you note to someone,
