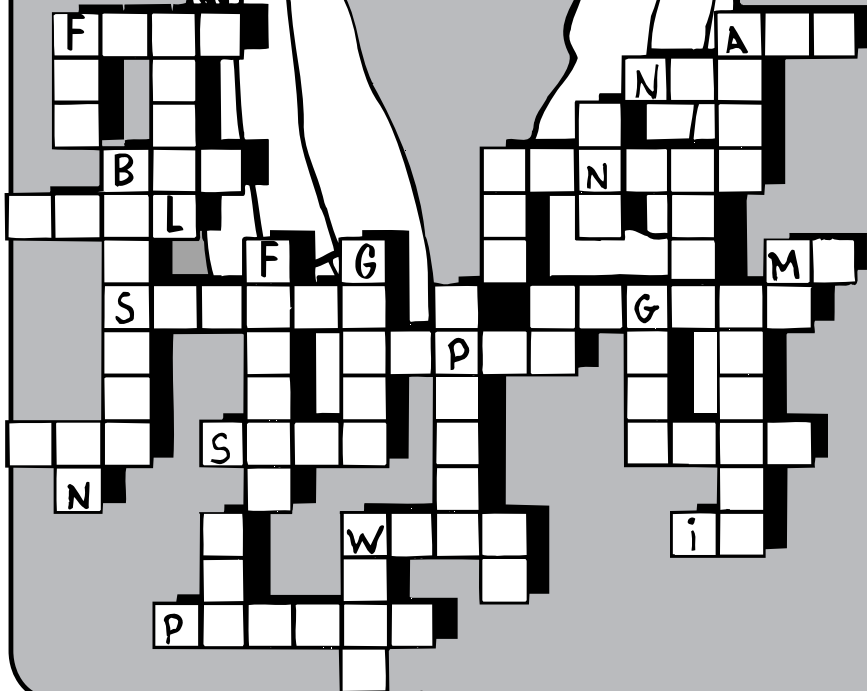

HE HAS FILLED THE HUNGRY WITH GOOD THINGS.**

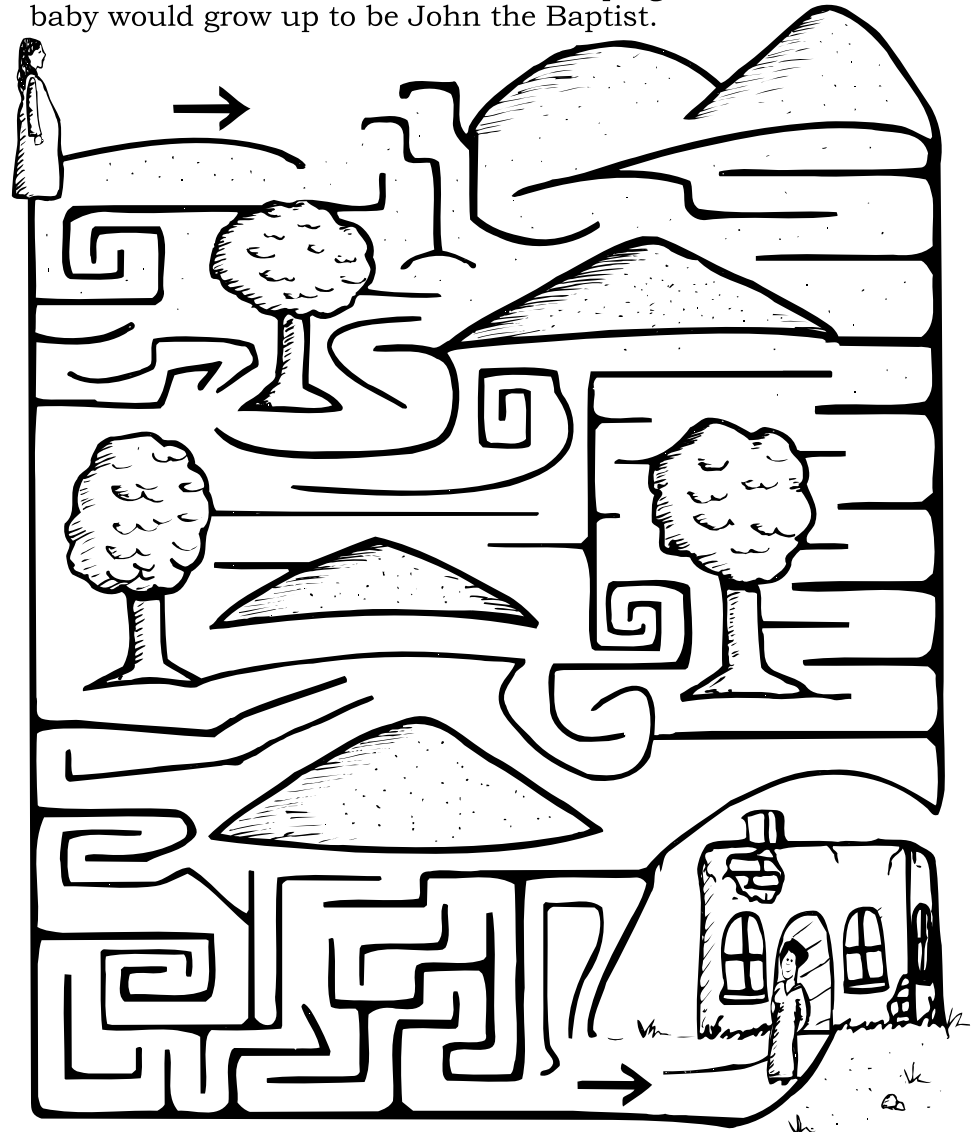
All of Mary's words fit into the crossword. Can you do it? Words that are repeated fit only once.

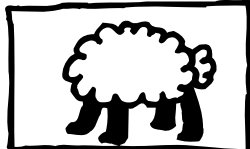

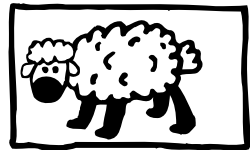
