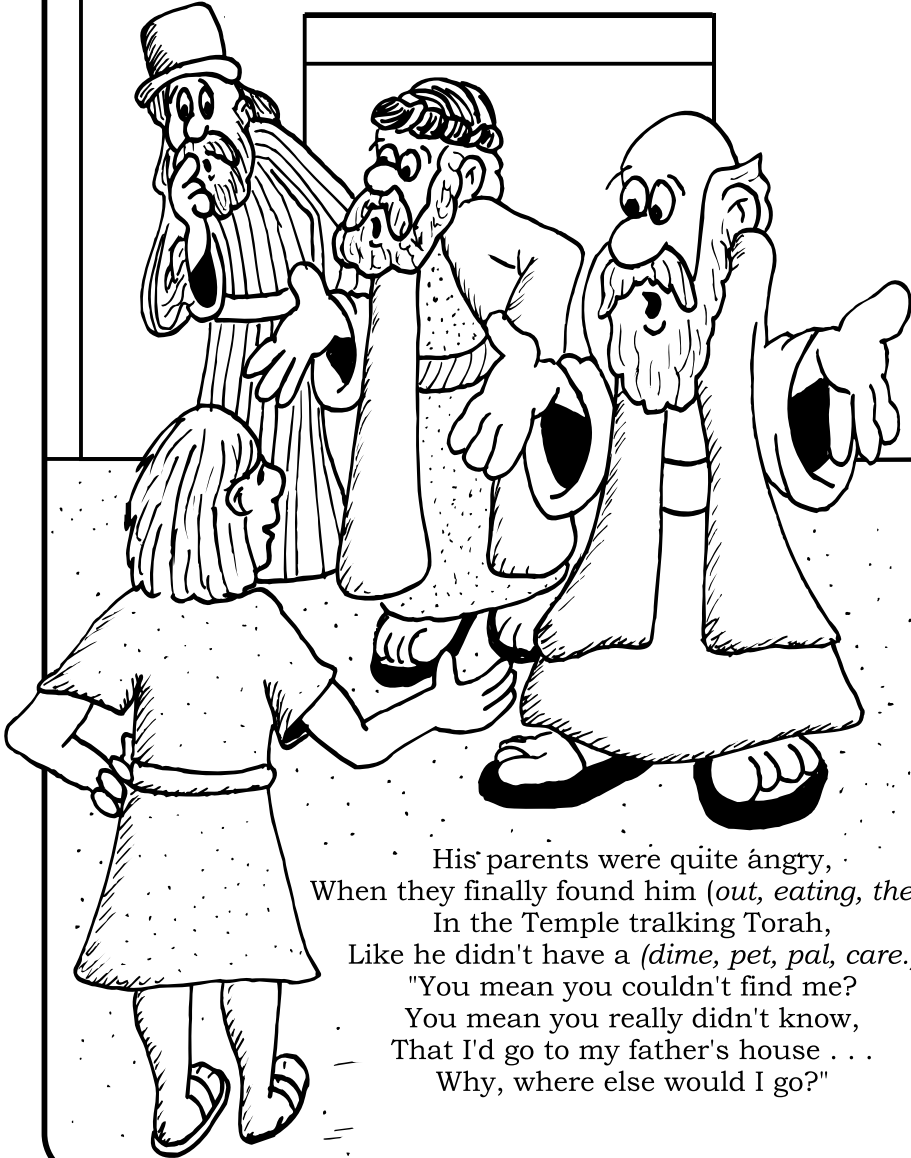


And when at last they found him,

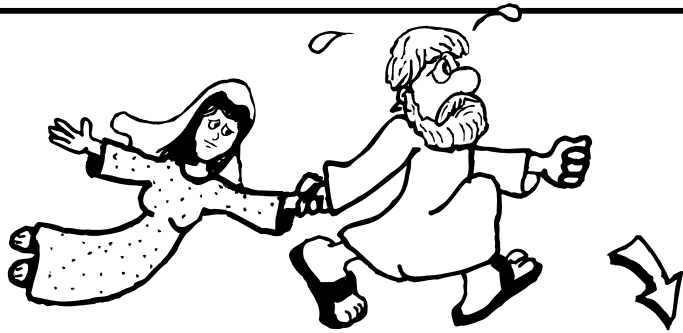
Circle the correct words at the end of the rhyming lines.

She couldn't find him (*out, hair, in anywhere.*)

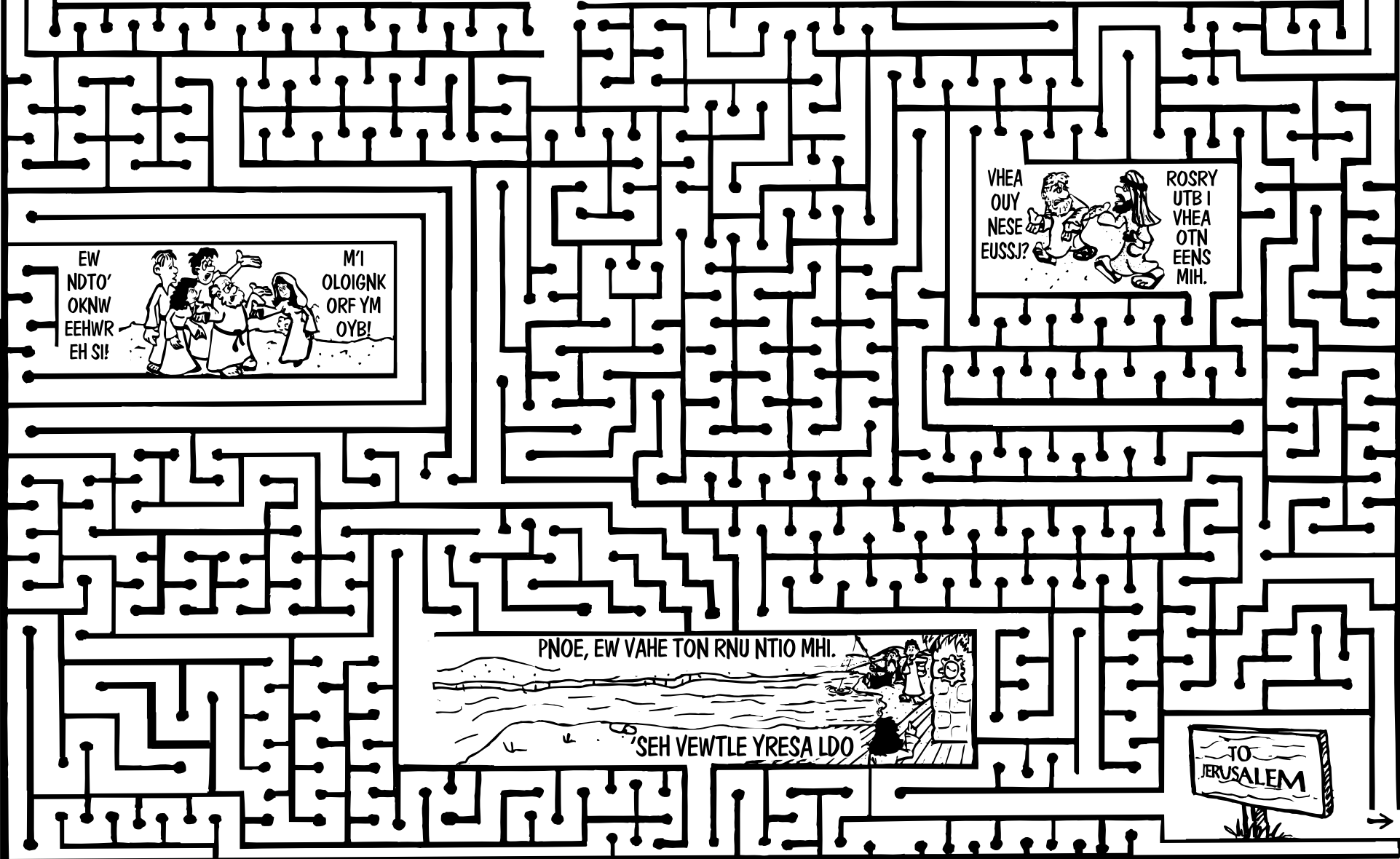


He was as gone as gone can be,
