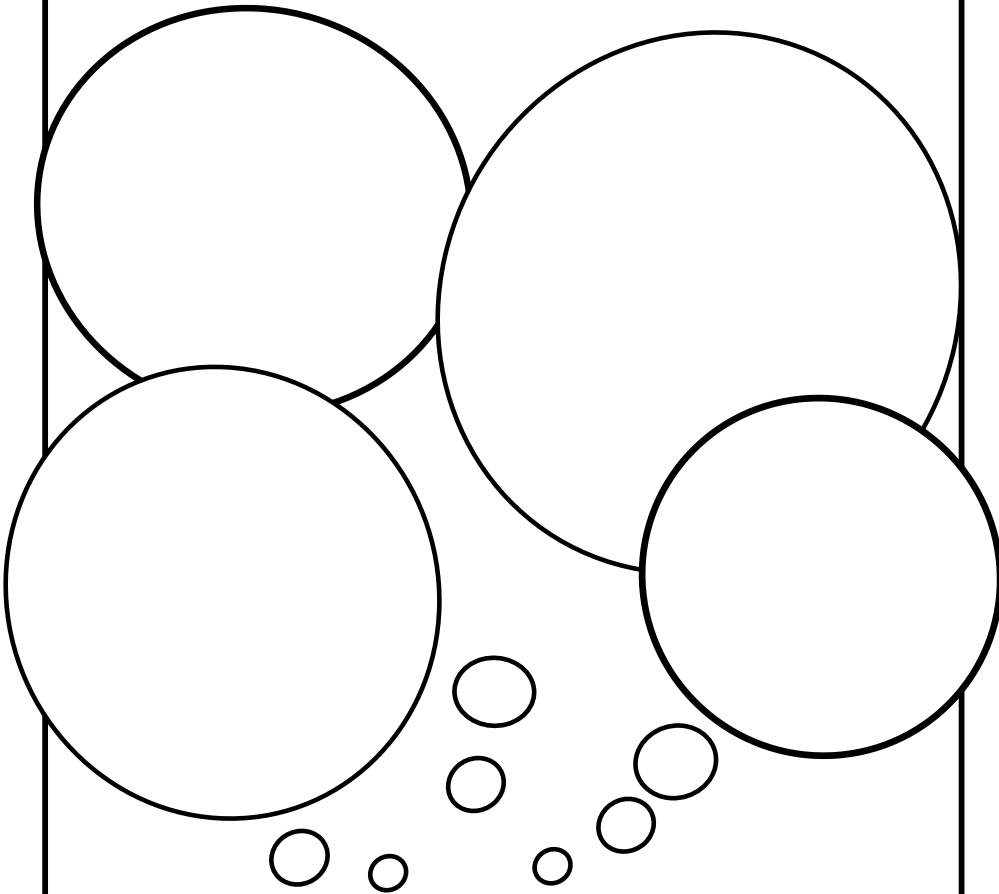


Do you ever think about the great things

God has done, in the bubbles.

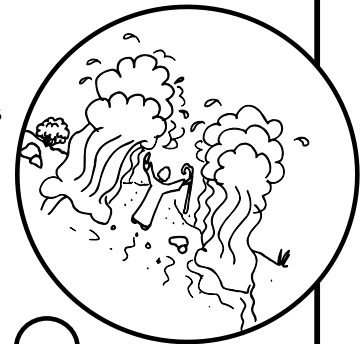
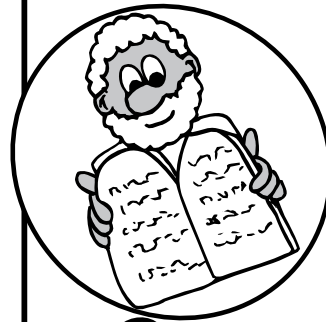

Deut. 26; Luke 4:1-13

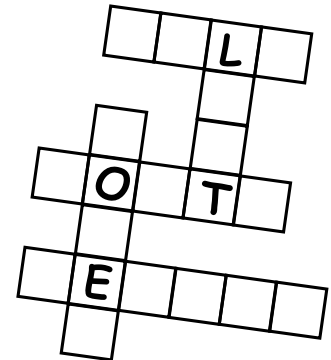

Moses told God's people never to forget the great things God had done for them. Do you ever think about the things God has done for you?



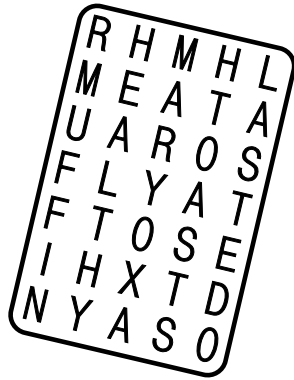
The underlined words fit here.
