AND HOW GOD MADE YOU WELL!



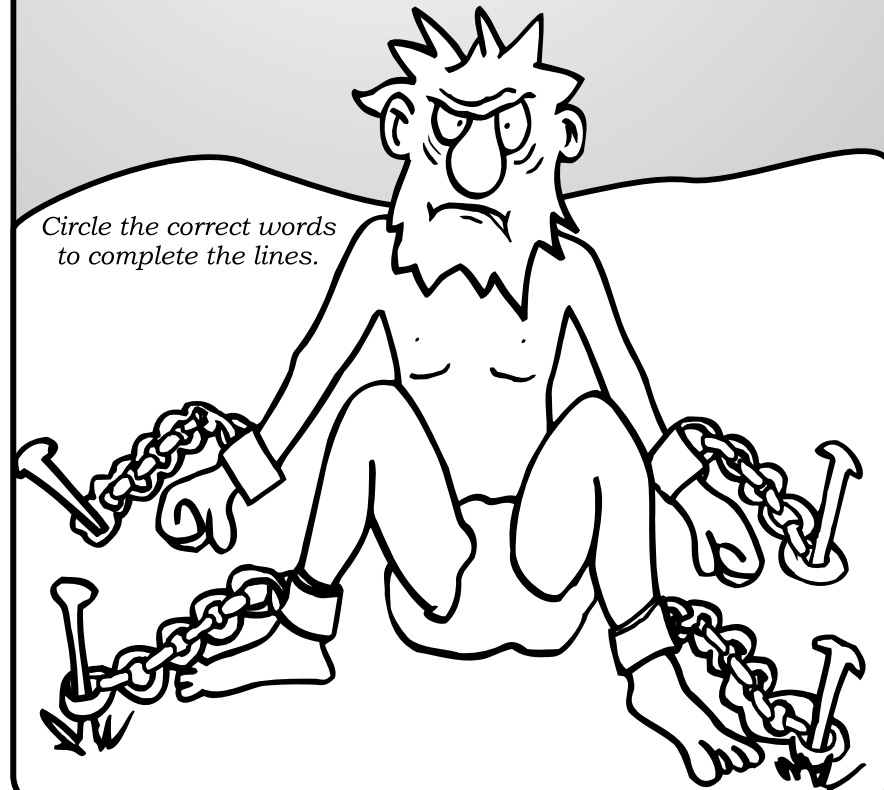
# Kidsword

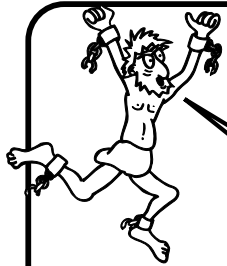
Luke 8:26-39
