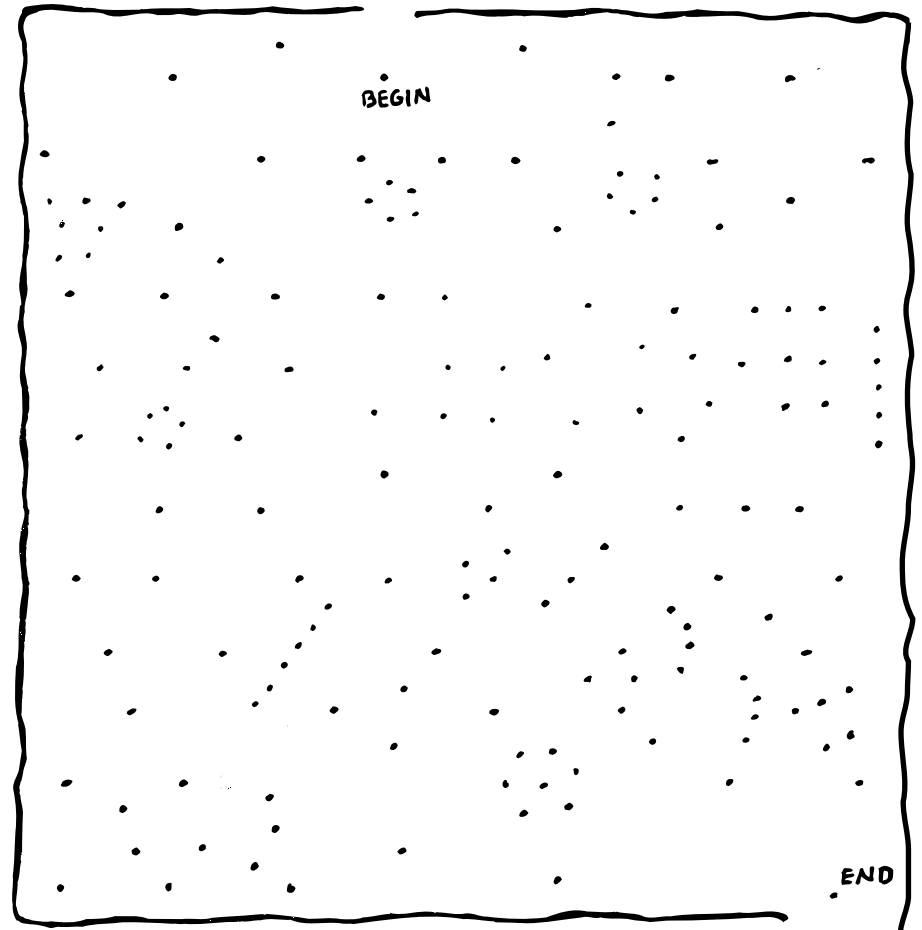


# Kidsword

Luke 9:51-62

Jesus said, "Anyone who puts a hand to the plow and then looks back is not worthy of God's kingdom."

Plow this field with a line from beginning to end. Connect every dot without lifting your pencil, or crossing your line.



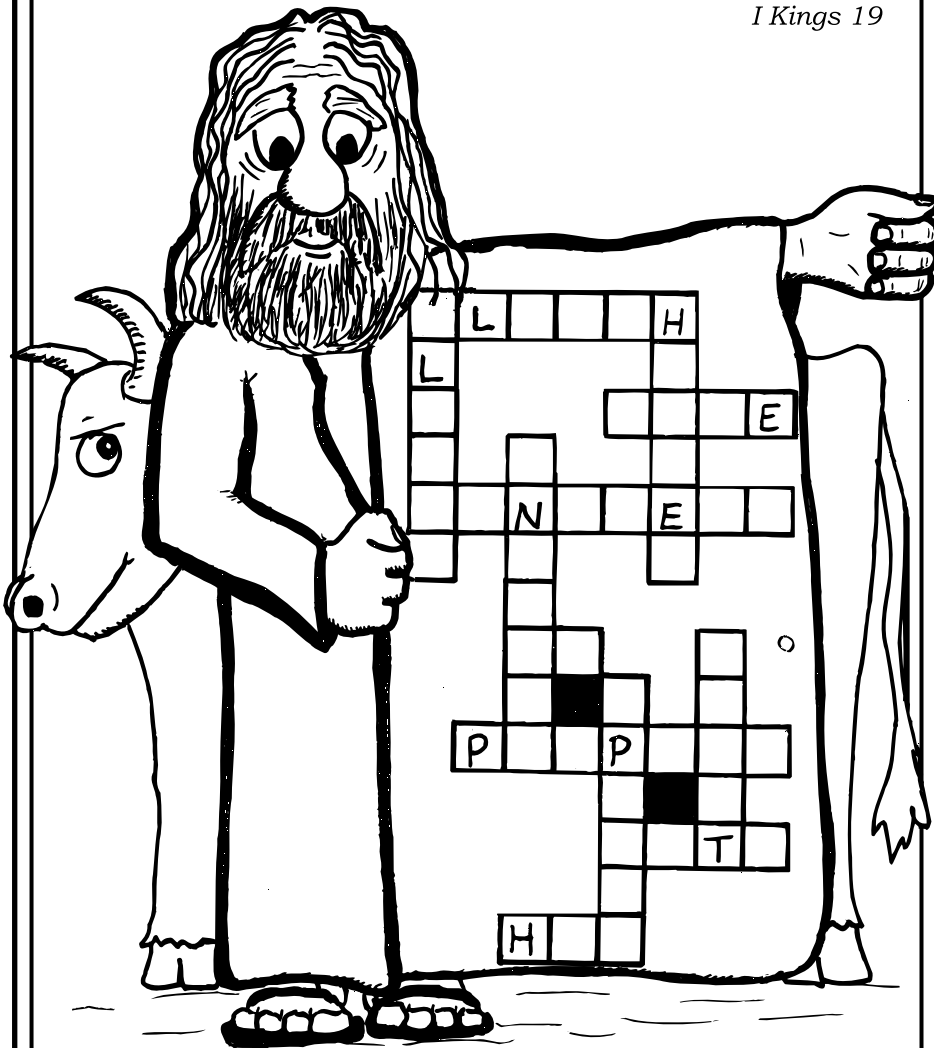
Think about this. What do you think Jesus meant? (A plow was a metal blade on a wood frame, pulled by oxen, guided by a worker. It was used to turn over the soil in a field, preparing it for planting.)

*Elijah* was a *great prophet* (a person who *speaks* and *acts* for God). He lived *hundreds* of years before Jesus. When God was ready to take him to *heaven*, *Elijah* chose *another* prophet to *take* his place.

He found *Elisha* plowing a field. *Elijah* threw *his* coat over *Elisha's* shoulders to show that he would be the next person chosen to speak for God.

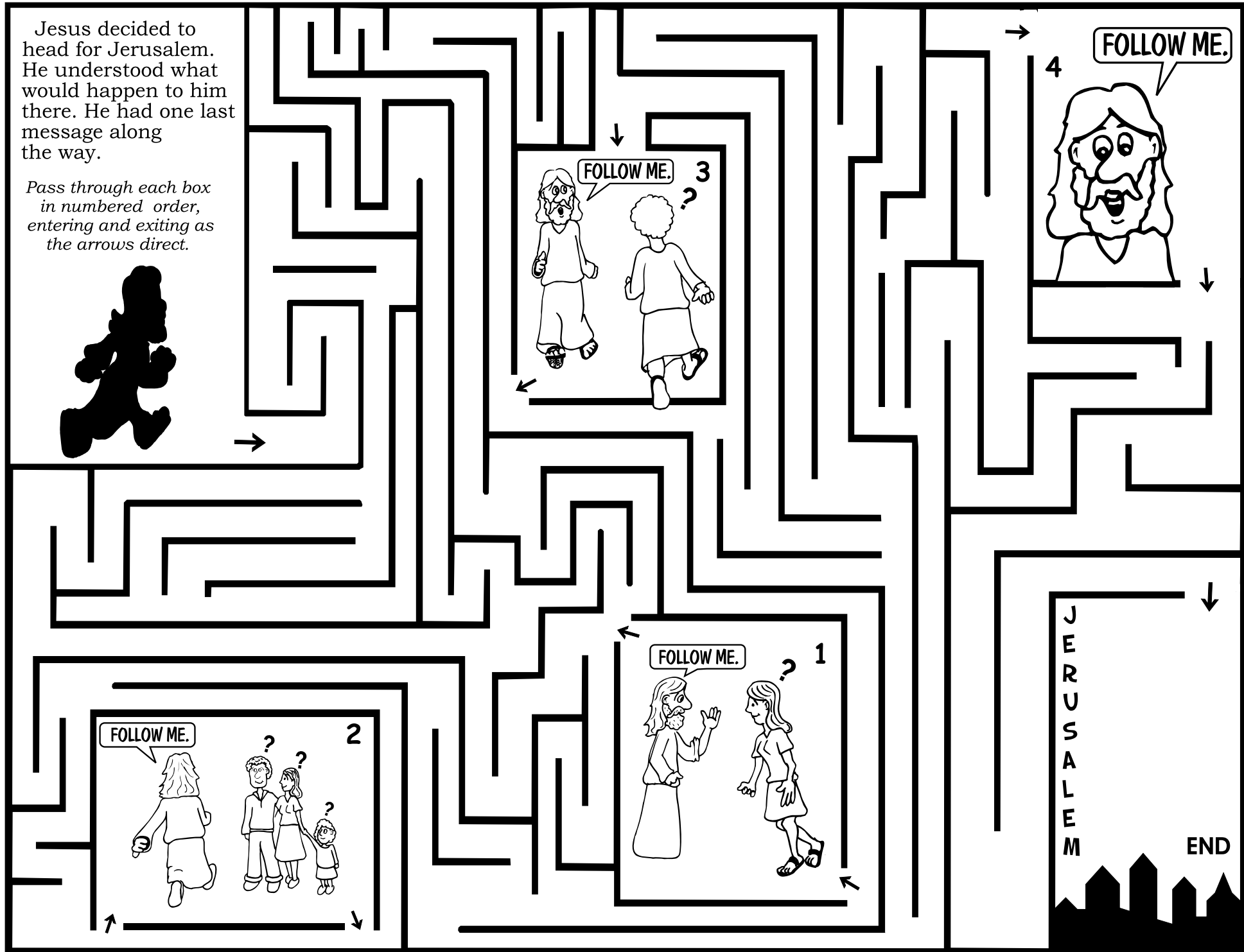
The words above in italics fit into the crossword.
