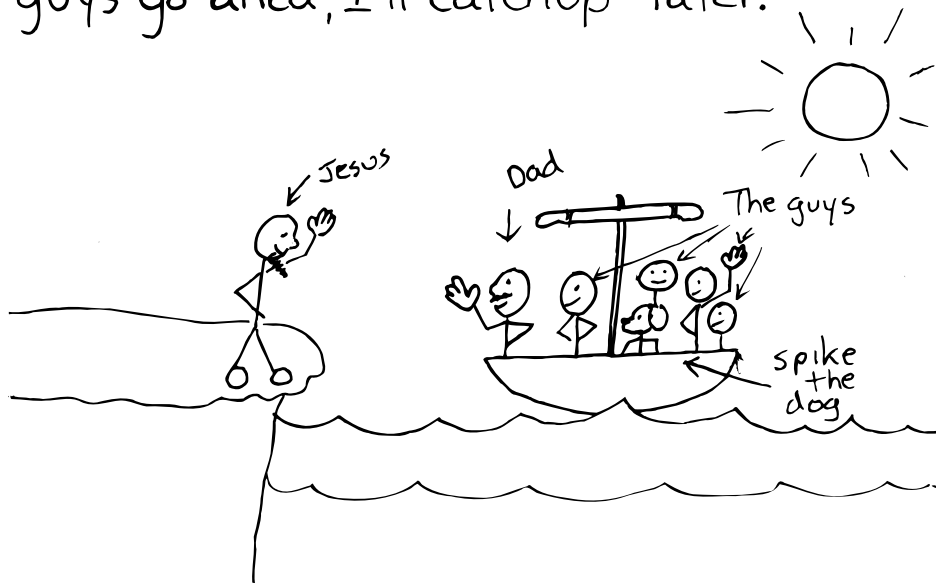

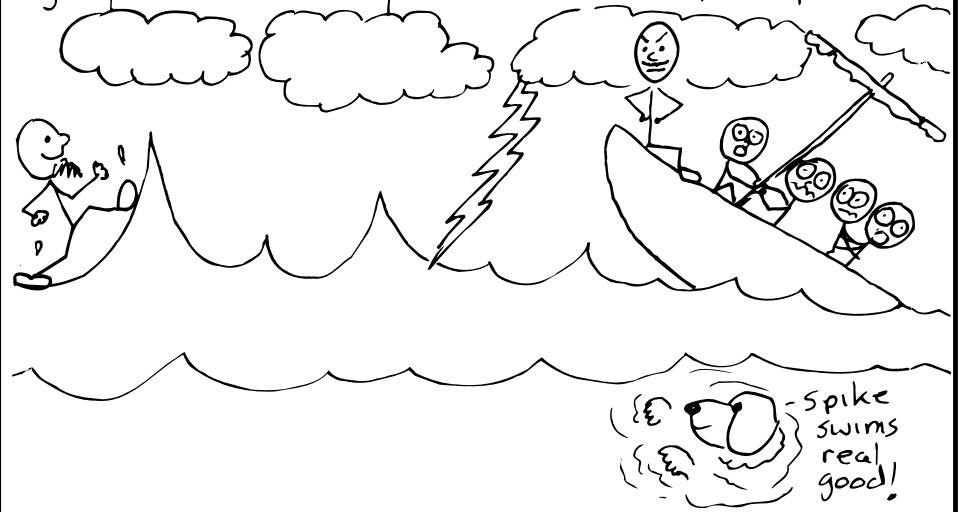


Try to tell what she has added to the story; also, correct her spelling and grammar, if you can.

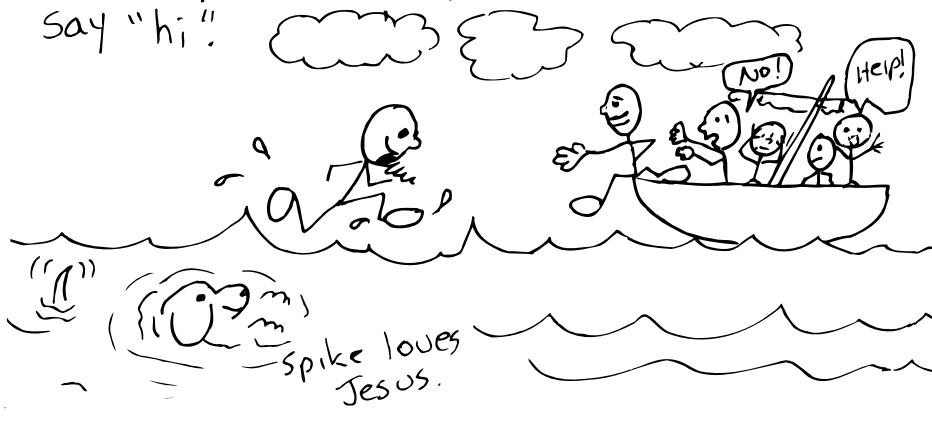
Jesus said to dad and the others, "You guys go ahead, I'll catch up later."
