




Matthew 18:15-20





Kinds of Prayer

- 1. Adoration: Giving God love and praise.
- 2. Confession: Telling God our sins and faults.
- 3. Thanksgiving: Saying "thanks" to God.
- 4. Supplication: Asking God to meet needs.

Put the letter (A,C,T, or S) beside each person that best describes his/her prayer. Some prayers should get more than one letter.
