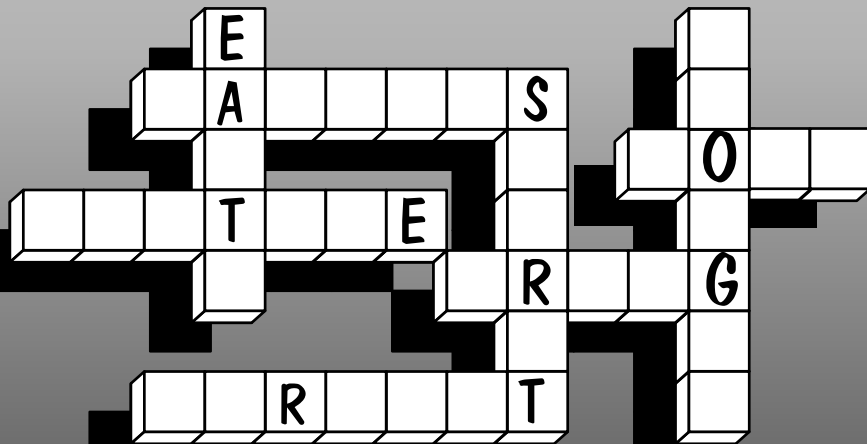


Isaiah 42
